We were blessed with a wonderful turnout for our first Ash Wednesday soup supper, and we welcomed about 55 people to eat and worship together. What a nourishing way to begin Lent together!

### **1 RECIPE**

### SWEET POTATO & COCONUT CURRY SOUP

Servings: 8 generous Prep Time: 30 min INGREDIENTS Cook Time: I hour NOTES Roast diced sweet 4 small-medium sweet potatoes potatoes in 1 tbs oil I medium yellow onion, diced @ 425F for 25 minutes, or until just 8 cloves minced garlic browned 4 cans light coconut milk Use an immersion 3 tablespoons Thai red curry paste blender, blender, or 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper food processor for a smooth soup 2 cups vegetable broth Salt and black pepper, to taste

#### DIRECTIONS

- 1. Wash, peel, and dice sweet potatoes (see notes)
- 2. Heat oil and sweat onions until they begin to brown
- 3. Add garlic and cook for 1 minute
- 4. Stir in curry paste and season with salt
- 5. Add in sweet potatoes and cayenne pepper and stir well
- 6. Add in coconut milk (including the cream) and bring up to a simmer
- 7. Cook 25-30 minutes and season with salt and black pepper, until potatoes are fully tender
- 8. Mash potatoes gently and thin soup with vegetable broth (added by 1/2 cup)
- 9. Remove from heat and let cool slightly before blending to smooth texture
- 10. Reheat, check seasoning, and enjoy!

### SESSION HIGHLIGHTS February 2024

- Enthusiastically welcomed Matthew Mancini into membership by letter of transfer from Salix Bethel Church, Salix, PA
- Affirmed the decision to switch from Optimum internet and Vonage phone services to Metronet for both internet and phone services, resulting in \$684 annual savings over a three year contract
- Approved calling a Meeting of the Corporation for Sunday, March 17, 2024, immediately following worship for the purpose of electing officers of the corporation
- Approved Building & Ground's Spring Work Day for the congregation for Saturday, March 16, beginning at 9:00 a.m. (rain date is March 23)

- Approved restructuring the Session's 8 standing committees to form 4 main Ministry Areas




