A Mighty Fortress Is Our God

Written by Martin Luther around 1527, this hymn became one of the most beloved hymns of the Protestant Reformation. The early 16th century was an era of tremendous social, political, and economic transition. It was also an era of religious conflict. Luther, through the words of this hymn, assures us that no matter what we are experiencing, God's care and love for us never falters.

A mighty fortress is our God, a bulwark never failing. Our helper he, amid the flood of moral ills prevailing. For still our ancient foe doth seek to work us woe. His craft and power are great, and armed with cruel hate, on earth is not his equal.

Did we in our own strength confide, our striving would be losing, were not the right man on our side, the man of God's own choosing. Dost ask who that may be? Christ Jesus, it is he. Lord Sabaoth his name, from age to age the same, and he must win the battle.

CALL TO CONFESSION

In the presence of God's goodness we recognize our failings. Seeking God's mercy, let us confess the truth about our motivations, our choices, our lives that we might embrace the grace God offers.

Increase our hope, enlarge our hearts and keep us alert to the wonders of your work in the world every day. Hear now our silent, individual confessions.
